The Schedule

- ★ The Competition is taking place at Roy Wilkins Auditorium in St. Paul on Saturday, January 30th, 2010.

- ★ Admission is \$15 for adults and \$10 for students in grades K-12. Children not in school yet are free. This fee will be charged one time per person. In the event you want to leave and come back you will need to have your hand stamped. You will need both your ticket and hand-stamped to regain admittance.

All Spectators will purchase tickets outside of the lobby of Roy Wilkins and enter the auditorium at this point. All seating for spectators is located in the balcony, with the exception of limited seating on the main floor for the handicap and their families. Signs will be placed throughout the RiverCentre directing you towards our event.
